



BEHAVIOUR POLICY
CORONAVIRUS ADDENDUM
September 2020

In these exceptional times we have reviewed our Behaviour Policy. We would expect all pupils, staff and parents to follow our normal behaviour policy. It has been necessary to add the following expectations for pupils and staff in school:

When pupils are in school we expect them to follow the rules below which will maintain safety for all:

- Arrive promptly at school without lingering to talk to friends or other families at the gates or on the playground
- Go to classrooms straight away
- Maintain social distancing – keep a 2 metre distance at all times
- Keep left in corridors
- Move around the site when supervised
- Wash hands in line with hand hygiene expectations
- Stay with your own 'pod' – no mixing
- Keep to the 'Catch it, Bin it, Kill it' approach to maintaining hygiene
- Avoid touching their eyes, mouth and nose with hands
- Use their own resources and stationary packs
- Do not share food, drink, cutlery, cups or bottles
- Keep all personal belongings as instructed by class teachers
- Use the toilets assigned to their class 'pods'
- Deliberate spitting, breathing hard or coughing at another person will usually result in immediate exclusion.

These amendments to our expectations have been put in place to ensure the implementation of hygiene and protective measures which, we hope, will lead to a safe return to school for all pupils and staff.
