English – Writing

In English, we will be looking at lots of exciting books to inspire our writing. We will build on the skills we learned in the previous term and use more adventurous language and grammar choices. We will be looking at a variety on Non-Fiction pieces of work.

We use Kinetic Letters as our handwriting scheme at Harrison. We will continue to work on the correct formation of letters and numbers throughout the year.

Joining will be taught towards the end of Year 2 in the Summer term.



Maths



In maths, we begin the term by learning about money. We will then move on to multiplication and division where we will learn written methods to solve a variety of problems and secure our 2,5 and 10 times tables.

In the second half term we will start by looking at Fractions of shape, objects and number.

Later this term, your child will be given login details to use Times Table Rockstars after the teaching of Multiplication in school - <https://play.ttrockstars.com/>.

Please encourage your child to log on and play the games. We will set challenges for homework tasks throughout the year.

Reading

It is important to hear your child read at least three times each week as this will increase fluency and understanding. Children should be encouraged to read a range of different texts. Oxford Owl and SORA are great resources that can be used at home and there are a wide selection of books on their sites. You can find details about using SORA here: <https://youtu.be/sYiXUP9ruG4>. If you do not have your child's library card number to access this, please contact your class teacher and we will provide you with this.

Please ensure that your child has their books in school everyday as we will be using them in our class reading sessions.

We visit the school library weekly. Children are able to choose a book to take home and share but must remember to return it. Please make sure children have their library books with them on Thursdays.



Home Learning

Your child will receive home learning weekly. This will include a spellings task and either an English or Maths task which should take no longer than 20 minutes to complete. Home Learning will be given out on a Friday, to be handed in on the following Wednesday. It is important for children to do these homework tasks as it helps them to consolidate their school learning in a 1:1 environment with an adult at home. Children will be rewarded with merit points for completion of homework tasks and can also earn a merit point for each time they read at home to an adult too; as long as this is recorded on their reading card and handed in on a Wednesday.

Foundation Curriculum

Science

During this term we will be learning about animals and their habitats.



Computing

We will be learning about online safety and our digital footprint.

Music

During the term we will use different musical instruments to explore pitch, tempo and dynamics.

RE

We will be looking at the concept of 'remembering' with a particular focus on Judaism.

In our outdoor PE sessions with Mrs Tata; we will be developing our throwing and catching skills during Spring 1 and will then develop our football skills during Spring 2. In our indoor PE sessions; we will explore movement through dance.

History

We will learn about what bullying is and who we can talk to.
