English – Writing

In **English**, our first units will largely be related to our Science theme of Space; we will look at the features of biographies and discussions and will create space poetry. Our text study will be on 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes.

After half term, we will look at story 'The Last bear' and Shakespeare's play 'A Midsummer Night's Dream'.



Maths



In **maths**, we will begin by working on place value, exploring numbers up to 1,000,000. Then, we will move on to addition and subtraction and multiplication and division. We will end the term studying fractions.

Problem solving and reasoning skills will be explored across all areas.

Home Learning

Your child will receive home learning each week, including both an English task and a Maths task. These should take approximately 30 minutes each and will be given out on a Friday, to be handed in on the following Wednesday. Your child will be given spellings each week based on existing misconceptions and the most common medium frequency words, which they will practise every day in school and should practice these daily at home too.

This half term, there will be a piece of project home learning for the children to complete: an exhibit for our annual space fair. Whilst this is being completed, children will not receive English home learning.

In addition to this, please continue to ensure your child is challenging themselves with reading material and that they continue to read regularly at home by themselves and to an adult. They can use their SORA account to access ebooks if they wish. We also encourage them to continue to use Times Table Rock Stars to practice their times tables and keep them at their fingertips!

<u>Swimming</u>

This half term **Y5W and Y5M** will have swimming sessions on a Friday. Please can children bring their kits in a named bag on their day.

Y5R will be swimming in the Summer term

All children have an outdoor P.E. slot on Tuesdays so need to come into school wearing a suitable P.E. kit on this day. **Y5R** will also have an indoor slot on Friday.



Foundation Curriculum

Science

We will be studying Earth and Space culminating in the exciting Space Science Fair. Our other topic for the term focuses on light.

Geography

We will be learning key skills such as time zones, map reading and grid references.

History

After half term, we will study the Tudors and discuss whether Henry VIII was a good or bad king.

Art & DT

In art, we will be exploring how different colour blends can allow us to create other-worldly landscapes and abstract space creatures. We will be making bread as part of our DT project.

Music

Children will be studying Music Tech this term with Mr McBeath from Hampshire Music Service.

RF

We will be exploring the theme of peace and how this is discussed within Buddhism, before experiencing Buddhist meditation and relaxation techniques for ourselves.

PSHE

We will be looking at how to safely communicate with our friends.

Computing


This term we are covering the units, 'We are Bloggers' and 'We are Directors'

E-safety continues to be a priority at Harrison and when the children are at home. This includes using: You Tube, Instagram, Facebook, Twitter and email. The minimum age to open an account on Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Pinterest, Tumblr, Kik and Snapchat is 13. You Tube requires account holders to be 18, but a 13-year-old can sign up with a parent's permission. Despite these clearly stated and published age restrictions, large and growing numbers of children 12 and under are using social media networks often with their parent's knowledge and consent. E-safety is therefore of paramount importance.
