Welcome back and a Happy New Year to you all. The children have worked really hard so far this academic year and we have already launched our new and exciting topics. This newsletter outlines the curriculum for the spring term.

English and Maths

We will be continuing to focus on different text-types in English, which will include non-chronological reports, poetry, diary, narrative and discursive writing. We will be analysing texts together as a whole class this term, particularly focussing on answering questions which involve the skills of inference and deduction. Within Maths, we will ensure children are secure and confident in performing operations with fractions and are able to use and understand ratio and algebra.

Home Learning

Your child will continue to receive their home learning tasks on a Friday, to be handed in the following Wednesday. Please can we ask that you go through home learning with your child to ensure they are completing work to the best of their ability, before handing it in. We



are trying to encourage the children to apply their spelling and handwriting skills to all aspects of their work. Home learning tasks will be English and maths related activities to apply their learning. In addition to this, children should read regularly at home and practise their times tables. As ever, good quality home learning, which is handed in on time, will be rewarded with our merit point system. Please remember children can access SATs Bootcamp, SORA and

Times Table Rock stars at home.

SATS BOOT CAMP

All children should have a log in for SATs Bootcamp and have been shown how to use this resource by their teachers.

It has a range of tasks, tests and explanation videos of English and Mathematics task that will support the children in their year 6 learning. Please encourage your child to access this at home. If, your child has misplaced their login, their class teacher can provide a replacement.

There will be a **year 6 SATs information evening** that is planned to take place in school on **Wednesday 25th February at 6pm**. Mrs Gmitrowicz will send further details nearer the time to confirm this.

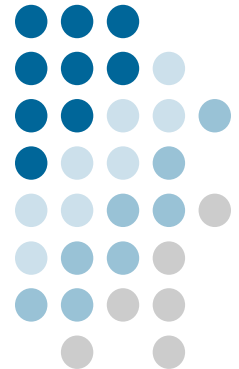

Science

Geography

Music
