What are we learning this term?

Literacy - During the first half term we will enjoy sharing familiar traditional tales such as The Gingerbread Man and The Three Billy Goats Gruff. We will be discussing main characters and events and retelling the story. After half term we will explore a variety of non fiction texts looking at key features and using them to find out facts and information.

Phonics - In Phonics we will continue to learn Phase 3 phonemes and HRS words. In Phase 4 we will recap all previously taught sounds and begin to blend and segment longer words containing consonant blends.

Maths - We will continue to develop our knowledge of numbers 6-10, recognising, ordering, counting accurately and the composition of those numbers.

We will also learn about different 4 sided shapes and explore mass and capacity.
