To keep us safe when using the computers we will...

We pledge to be good online citizens by...

- Only choose to play safe and appropriate games agreed with your adult.
- Tell an adult if you're going online.
- Don't talk to strangers online and keep your personal information PRIVATE.
- Let an adult know if someone has sent you an unkind message and block them.
- Never meet up with strangers from the internet.
- Passwords: keep them private, don't use simple ones (like your name or numbers), try to use a range of numbers and letters and something memorable. Keep your passwords updated.
- Don't share passwords with friends or anyone else except trusted adults.
- Log out of any apps once you are finished using them.
- Share equipment carefully with others and think about your screen time.
- Keep equipment safe: keep food and drink away from technology, only carry 2 laptops at a time and 4 ipads at a time and make sure to clean them after you have used them.
- If you are playing online, only send positive messages.
- Avoid things too good to be real- they are probably scams, virus or hackers.
- Always ask for permission before downloading or playing new games, especially if they cost money.
- Use nicknames to avoid sharing personal names.
- Treat any technological devices with RESPECT and look after them.
- Report anything you are worried about.
